

Gift Aid (Tax Relief for Charities) Form

Did you know that you could increase the value of your donation to ATLA without it costing you a penny?

Gift Aid is a scheme to encourage individuals and businesses to donate more money to charity. Under the scheme, UK charities can claim back the basic rate tax already paid on gifts of money received from individuals who pay or have paid UK tax.

You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).

All you have to do is sign and return the declaration below.

Notes:

- 1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying ATLA.
- 2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that ATLA reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
- 3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- 4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the ATLA Treasurer.
- 5. Please notify ATLA if you change your name or address.
